Got kids?

Kids are part of our life and we love them being involved on a Sunday! So we don't (usually) run separate kids' activities but instead try to keep it all varied enough for kids to participate and enjoy (especially on G-Rated & Prayer Sundays).

If your child struggles to concentrate, or to play quietly when adults are talking then there's books and toys in the lounge, a sandpit in the courtyard and a playspace on the Hill Street side.

On Sunday 21st March we will be holding our first family community carnival for 2010. These are great events, popular with local kids and families, and a great way to serve our community, and show the love of Jesus to our neighbours. It will take the place of our normal Sunday morning gathering:

Who's in charge?

What's the deal with no senior pastor?

Our leadership group (aka 'elders'), pastors, and other leaders share the responsibilities of oversight and pastoral care, in submission to Jesus, and with love and respect for each other and our community. We *all* want to rely on Jesus directly for our faith, our spiritual growth and direction, and to be our 'gobetween' with God, and we aim to encourage one another in this walk.

Note we are part of the Baptist Union of Victoria (BUV) and seek to abide by the BUV's Duty of Care policy. The elders are your first port of call with any concerns.

Where's the money?

Like the earliest Christians, we aim to share our resources with each other and those in greater need. But unlike many churches we don't normally do this by taking up an offering, (e.g. passing a plate or bag around).

Pooling and sharing our money (and other resources) is part of life for people who are committed to what Jesus is doing through this church, and is not expected of visitors. Of course visitors are welcome to support us if you want to!

What's the money used for? To support our paid staff; to cover costs for our property, equipment & community projects and programs; to support & invest in each other; and to provide assistance to our friends and neighbours in need, such as our overseas partners and organisations.
